

Be the next... Faculty Rep



Each of KU's four faculties elects two students to lead academic representation within that faculty - one undergraduate and one postgraduate.

It is a voluntary role, running from July to June.

Main duties and Responsibilities

- Lead and support School Community Reps across your faculty.
- Meet regularly with faculty leaders and Student Officers.
- Coordinate faculty-level student voice meetings to help Course Reps prepare for Student Voice Committees.
- Represent your peers by sharing feedback, tracking change, and reporting back.
- Sit on Student Council to represent all Academic Reps, hold the Student Officers to account, and help shape Policies of the Union.
- Access to other developmental opportunities.
- Lead and support Campaign Action Groups.



Training and Support:

- Introductory training in July from the KSU Student Voice and Insight Team.
- Access to a Rep Handbook, recordings, and live sessions.
- Added to communication channels for ongoing updates and support.
- Opportunities for drop-in support from the Rep Coordinator and SU team.
- Guidance on how to collect feedback and communicate change effectively.
