Supporting Students Through the Cost of Living Crisis

Over the past year, I established a regular food bank which we're running every Monday, Tuesday and Thursday at PR and KH campus to support students facing financial hardship. This must not remain a temporary measure. It must become a structured and permanent support system. If elected, I will focus on making it permanent at the university. I will also work directly with the Cafe management to introduce cheaper and more meal deal options across campuses, including continental and culturally diverse options that reflect Kingston's international community.

International Students Support

As you know, I ran a successful campaign for international students' fee payments to introduce instalments, and this change is already in progress. To continue this important work and ensure international students get the support they deserve, I need your vote as your SU President. If elected, I will also establish a Dedicated International Transition Officer. This role will provide a named point of contact within the Students' Union, specially trained to support international students with:

- Right to rent guidance
- Employment hour limits
- GP registration and NHS access
- Weekly drop-in clinics (in person and online)

Over the past year, I've worked hard to deliver real change, making our university more inclusive, supportive, and student-focused.
